B.S. DEGREE IN HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PROFESSIONAL GOLF MANAGEMENT MAJOR Effective Spring 2010

Admission Requirements:

The Professional Golf Management (PGM) major is a limited access program. To be admitted to the PGM major, students must (1) have completed at least 52 semester hours, (2) have completed ACG 2021, CGS 2100, ECO 2013, ECO 2023, MAC 1105, and STA 2023 with a grade of "C-" or better in each course, and (3) have an overall GPA of at least 2.30 on all prior college level work.

Additional Information:

1. **PGM Majors must satisfy a number of supplemental requirements, including a “playing ability test,” several PGA workshops, and approved internships.** These requirements are outlined in the PGM Policies and Procedures Manual. PGM majors must complete 16 months of approved internship experience.
2. **Students are required to complete Management Internships for academic credit (HFT 3941) through the Dedman School as part of their major requirements (12 semester hours must be earned).** These internships will also count toward the PGA internship requirement.
3. **In addition to the requirements outlined above, each student must complete all University-wide requirements for graduation.** These requirements include liberal studies requirements, the multicultural requirement, the Gordon Rule writing requirement, the summer school requirement, the FSU residency requirement, and total hours requirements.
4. Students needing elective hours to satisfy the University 120 total hours requirement are encouraged to take additional courses from the list below that are taught in the Dedman School.

5. Typically, Hospitality Management courses are not offered in the Summer terms at the main campus. The Dedman School offers a Summer Study Program in Switzerland through International Programs. In addition, the Dedman School offers a Summer Resort Management Program in Destin, FL.
6. Transfer of upper-level hospitality courses must be from hospitality colleges at other 4-year, accredited institutions. These courses must carry prerequisites similar to those of the courses they are replacing, and must be approved by the Dedman School. Once enrolled at FSU, students should **not** take any course at another institution without first receiving approval from the Dedman School.
