John L. Carey Scholarship

- Students with Liberal Arts degree seeking graduate degree in Accounting
- \$5000 a year (renewable)
- Must express desire to obtain CPA
- **Deadline was April 1 (postmarked)**

Consortium for Graduate Study in Management

- Must be African American, Hispanic American or Native American
- Senior or recent grad seeking degree in management
- Must attend 1 of 13 associated institutions

EPA's National Network for Environmental Management Study Fellowship

- For majors relating to population control and environmental protection
- 3.0 GPA minimum requirement
- Must have completed 4 courses related to environmental studies
- **Deadline was February 2 (postmarked)**

Thomas R. Pickering Foreign Affairs Fellowship

- Seeks to attract sophomore students seeking a Foreign Service career in the US Dept. of State
- Award includes tuition, room and board and mandatory fees during junior and senior year of undergrad and first year of graduate
- Includes a summer institute, 2 internships and core curriculum
- Minimum of four and a half years service as a Foreign Service Officer required
- 3.2 GPA minimum requirement

Thomas R. Pickering Graduate Foreign Affairs Fellowship

- Seeks to attract senior or recent grads seeking a Foreign Service career in the US Dept. of State
- Award includes tuition, room and board, mandatory fees during first and second year of graduate studies, reimbursement for books and 1 round-trip travel
- 3.2 GPA minimum requirement
- Minimum of three years service as a Foreign Service Officer required

Charles B. Rangel International Affairs Fellowship Program

- Seeks to attract seniors or recent grads seeking a Foreign Service career in the US Dept. of State
- Awards up to \$32,500 annually towards masters degree in foreign affairs or related subject
- 3.2 GPA minimum requirement
- Fellows who obtain masters degrees are required to serve a minimum 3 years as a Foreign Service Officer
- **Deadline was January 23**
